This book is also limited to 100. A very appealing little street photography book.

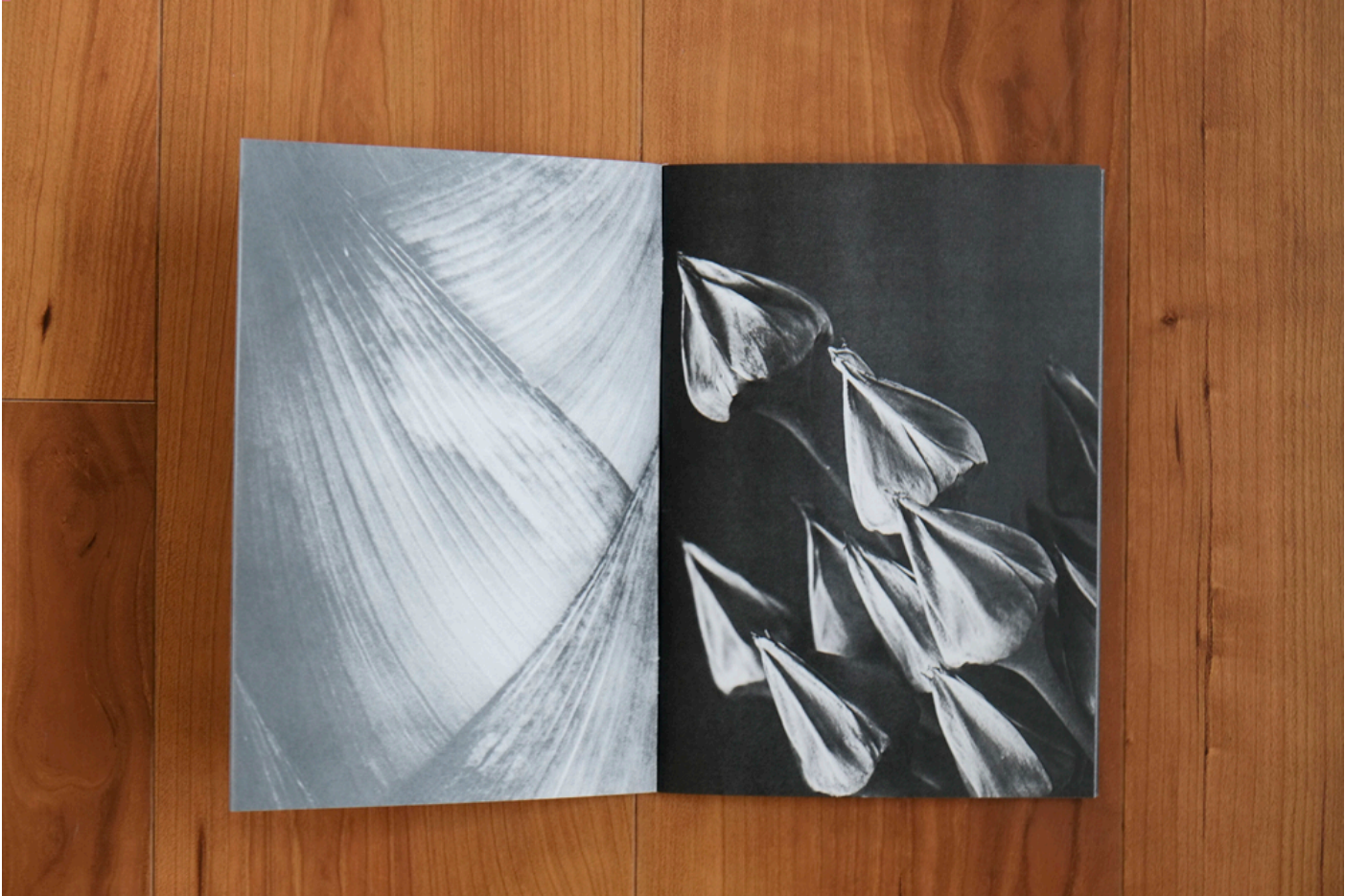

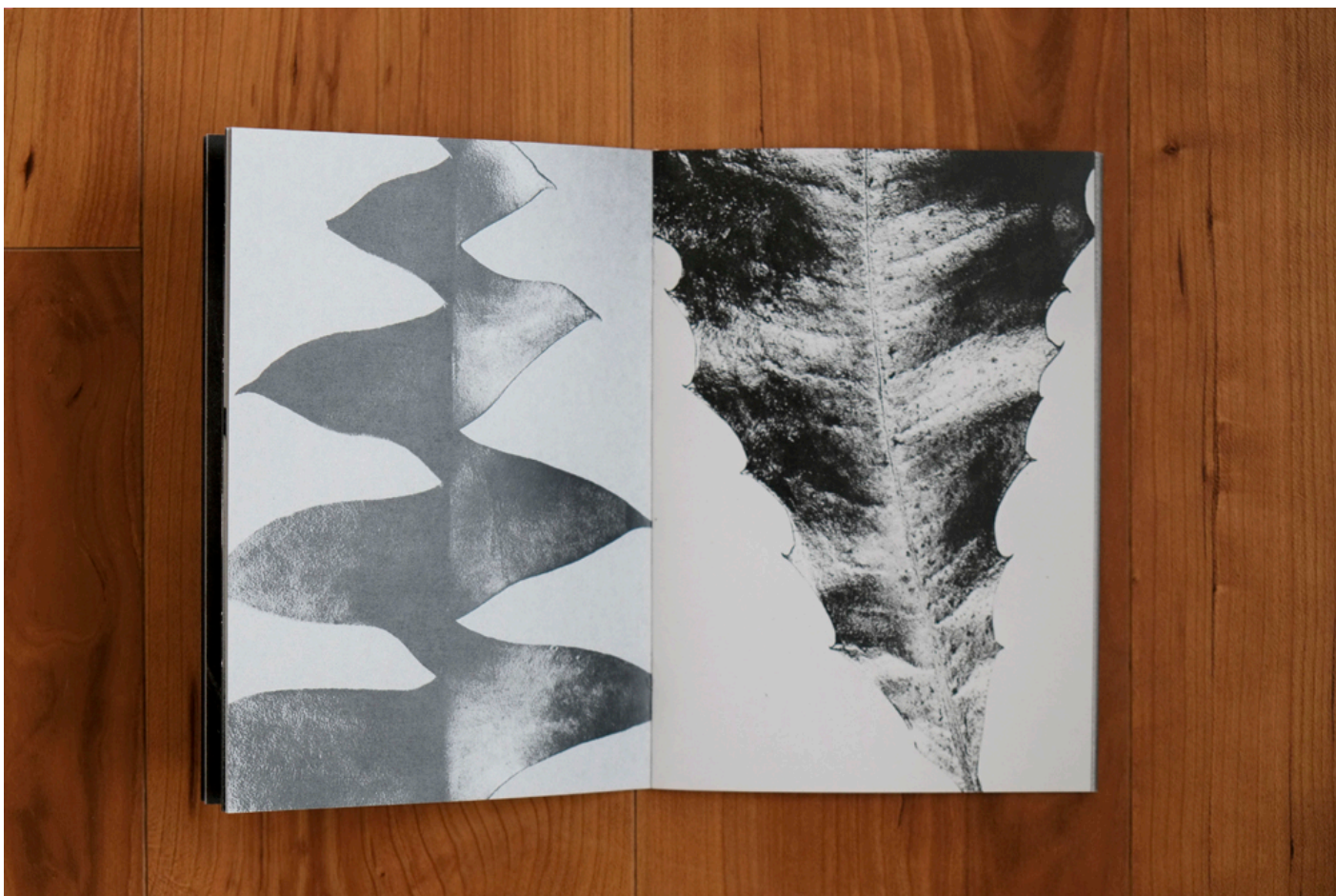


This is also on a limited run of 100. A very different look at the city, as if humans were no longer in the equation.
